

Level 1 Clinics

Abingdon, Bicester, Kidlington, Wantage,
Witney

Drop in service only

- Pregnancy testing
- Condom distribution
- STI testing & partner notification
Asymptomatic patients ONLY.
Please do not refer patients with symptoms to these clinics
- Testing for HIV and syphilis
- Testing for hepatitis B & C in at-risk groups and onward referral
- Treatment for chlamydia (NOT gonorrhoea)
- Emergency hormonal contraception
- Issuing of contraceptive pills, injections and related advice.
- Assessment for elective or emergency IUD/IUS and routine follow-up
- Contraceptive implant insertion (not removal)
- Contraceptive coil removal (not insertion)

Level 2 Clinics

Oxford (Rectory Road), Didcot

All level 1 services plus

- One-to-one health advice/motivational interviewing for interventions to reduce STI/unplanned pregnancy
- Syndromic management of vaginal itch and discharge (NOT tests - if diagnostic doubt/complex refer Level 3)
- Assessment and management of PID
- Assessment and management of genital ulceration (if diagnostic doubt refer Level 3)
- Assessment and treatment of genital warts
- Urgent referral to and from related specialties
- Testing for Hepatitis B and (vaccination where indicated in at risk groups)
- Management of problems with choice of contraception method
- IUD & IUS insertion (appointment only following assessment)

Level 3 Clinics

Oxford (Churchill), Banbury

All level 1 & 2 services plus

- Microscopy for diagnosis
- Treatment of men with urinary symptoms and/or genital discharge (please do NOT send women with UTI symptoms unless HSV suspected)
- Diagnosis and treatment of gonorrhoea, syphilis,
- Testing and referral on for hep B & C
- STIs in pregnant women
- Recurrent conditions (referral letter please)
- Tropical STIs
- Management of genital skin problems (referral letter please)
- HIV services - provision and FU for HIV prevention (PrEP) & PEPSE, HIV outpatient care, management of HIV partner notification
- HPV and Hep A vaccination for MSM
- Coordination of outreach clinical services for high risk groups
- Complex genital ulceration
- Health Advisor counselling
- Psychosexual counselling and
